Scheduled Events*

Officer's Row History Tour: This is a one hour, 1/2 mile easy walking tour along the historic Fort Vancouver Officers Row. You will meet a number of people in period dress from the 1850's to 1900. These characters will tell their stories of early settlement in Clark Co., WA and share information about the architecture of the houses on the row. The tour ends at Grant House, the oldest original structure on the row dating from 1849. Dedicated in honor of General U.S. Grant in 1879 and currently housing a fine restaurant, you may wish to stay on for drinks or dinner at the conclusion of the tour (no host).

Columbia River Gorge Tour: A 4 1/2 hour bus tour following the old Scenic Highway with a stop at Crown Point Vista House and Multnomah Falls. At Bonneville Dam and Fish Hatchery view salmon swimming up the fish ladders and visit Herman, a 70 year old, 500 pound, 11 foot sturgeon.

Tech Session: Nick Brann, a 25 year veteran of the automotive aftermarket will give an informative presentation on spark plugs. He will cover the importance of the proper heat range, how that can affect your engine, and the importance of proper spark plug gap. He will also be able to discuss other ignition system components and tips for quicker starting. There will be time for questions and answers. The tech session will be immediately followed by an Ask the Experts session.

Welcome Party: Life is a cabaret old chum, but this time around it's a circus. Enjoy the midway, complete with food, games and entertainment. We're talking foot long hotdogs, magic tricks, a caricature artist and an honest to goodness calliope. Enjoy snow-cones, cotton candy, ring-toss and other activities. It is your opportunity to dress as your favorite circus performer - dress up is NOT mandatory but encouraged. Please join us for a really big show!

Portland City Tour: A narrated 3 1/2 hour bus tour through Old Town, Chinatown and the West Hills overlooking the city with a stop at Portland's International Rose Test Garden. Also included is a tour of the historic Pittock Mansion.

Portland Sky Line Dinner Cruise: A 2 1/2 hour cruise on the Willamette River aboard The Portland Spirit. The cruise will feature an excellent buffet, entertainment, and narrative descriptions of notable points of interest. Transportation from the hotel and return will be via modern air conditioned tour buses. This tour will be limited to 350 persons.

Rice NW Museum of Rocks and Minerals: This will be a 4 hour bus tour to one of the most fascinating houses in the northwest. First built as a family home in 1953 and intended to house the Rice's rock collection when the family moved out. This was the first ranch style home admitted to the Historic Registry. It now houses a collection of rocks, minerals, fossils, gemstones and petrified wood that rival collections that have been shown at the Smithsonian and other national museums.

Fashion Show & Dessert Tea: – Ladies do you need a respite from all things Thunderbird? Fashion through the ages will present the evolution of ladies apparel from the 1840's to the 1950's. Enjoy the show while sipping tea or coffee, sampling cakes and chatting with friends old and new.

Wine & Beer Tasting: Five wineries, one brewery, a chocolatier, light dinner and a fabulous jazz trio. What a great way to spend a relaxing evening sampling some of the best of the Northwest. We've thought of all of the details so that you can enjoy a light supper, sample and purchase fine wine and chocolates while enjoying listening to the inspiring sounds of local jazz trio *The Elevators*.

Evening BBQ at Portland International Raceway: Watch the PIR Friday night festivities and enjoy a great BBQ meal with beverages. Event includes food and PIR spectator entrance fee.

Driving Tour: For those registered in touring class, this event will be worth ten bonus points. Drive through scenic and pastoral countryside to the Evergreen Flight Museum. The museum is built around the HK-1 Flying Boat built by Howard Hughes, also known as The Spruce Goose. Evergreen is also home to an OmniMax Theater, you may want to take in a show. A tour bus will be available for those not wishing to drive. After a box lunch maps will be provided for further exploration of Oregon's wine country, nearby antique shops or a direct route back to the hotel.

Awards Banquet: Each entrée will begin with a fresh spinach salad and your choice of fresh baked artisan bread. The entrees are: 1) grilled parmesan crusted breast of chicken with tomato caper butter sauce, rosemary baby red potatoes and fresh vegetables; 2) grilled flank steak with horseradish whipped potatoes, hickory pan-jus and fresh vegetables; 3) porcini crusted halibut on a bed of roasted vegetables with Yukon gold potatoes and lemon thyme butter. Dessert will be deep dish apple pie drizzled with caramel sauce.
